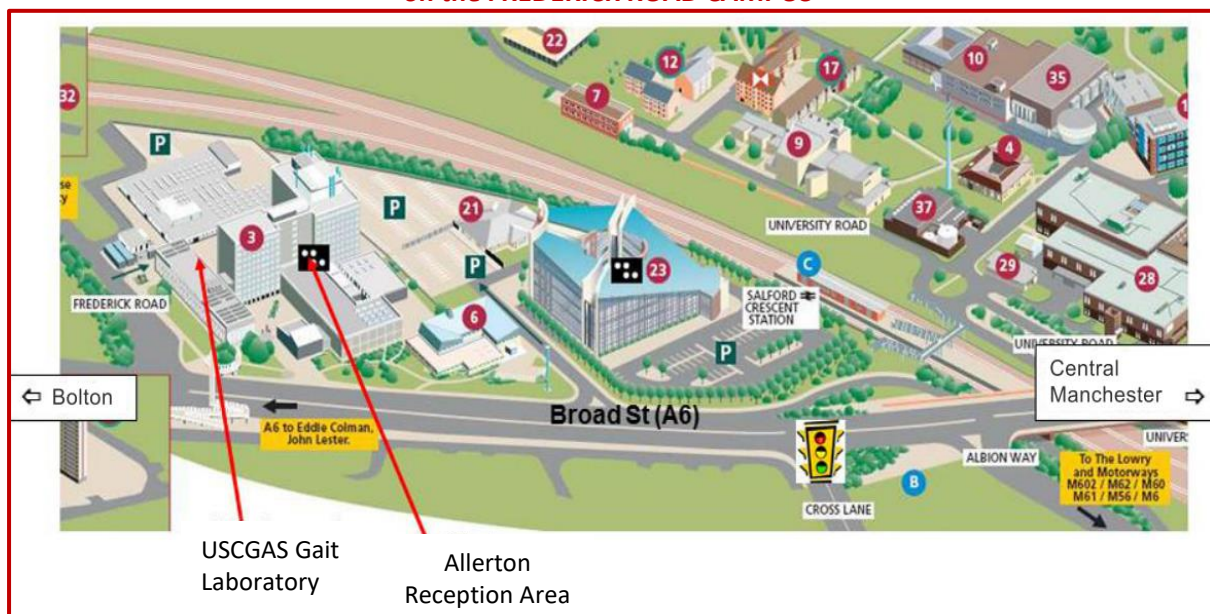

Travelling by car

Directions from the A6

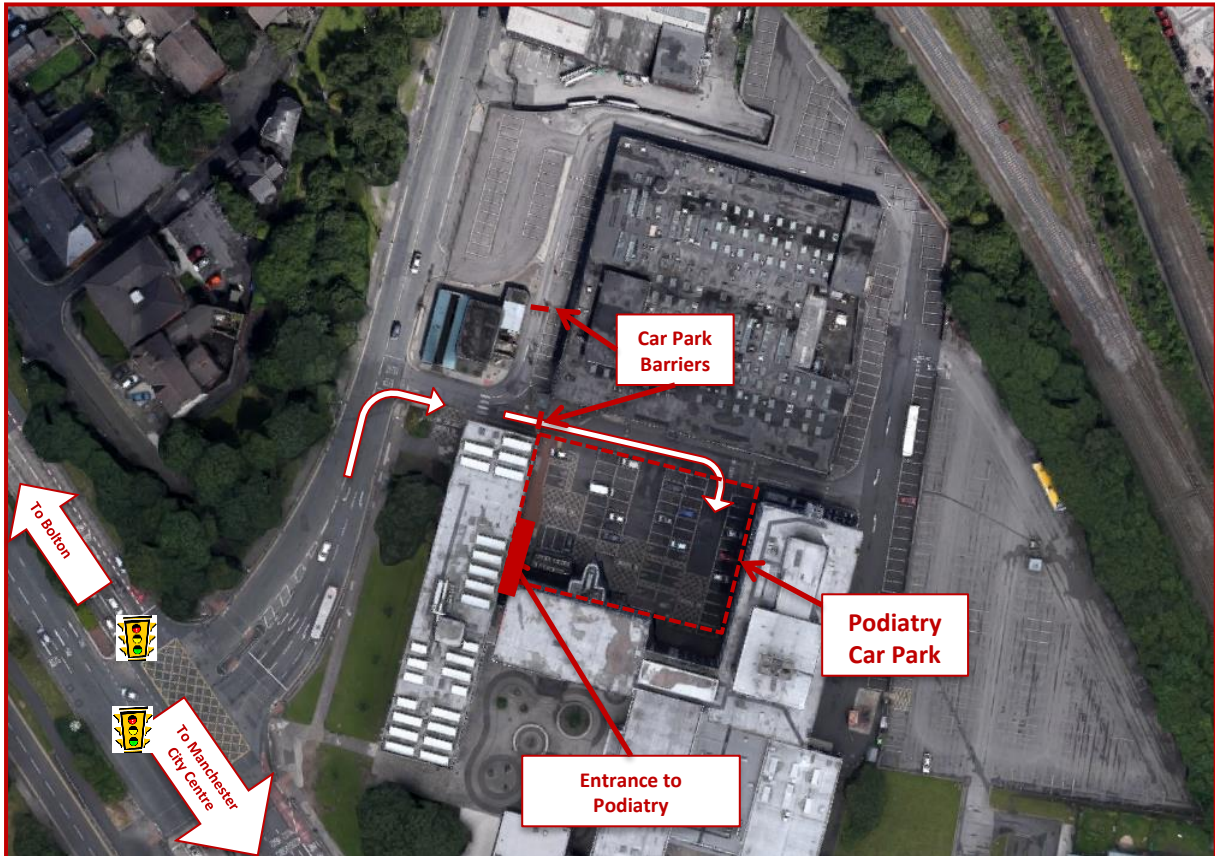
At the traffic lights, turn onto Frederick Road. Immediately take the first right turn into the Frederick Road Car Park.

Car parking

As you enter the car park, due to temporary work, there is no option to turn left as usual. Therefore, follow the diversion signs. Attempt to park in the first car park you come to (on your right), as this is outside the Podiatry building where the gait laboratory is located. If there is no parking available please follow the road round and park elsewhere in the university.

The map below shows where the entrance to the Podiatry building is located.



***Blue Badge Holders:** There are designated parking spaces available in the Podiatry car park, close to the entrance of the building.

Paying for parking

As you are attending a clinic, you will be exempt from parking charges. However, in order to be exempt, as soon as you have parked please visit the Podiatry department immediately and provide your car registration details to the reception staff.

Failure to report to the Podiatry reception immediately may result in you receiving a parking fine.

Travelling by train

Salford Crescent station is approximately 5 minutes walk from the the Frederick Road Campus.

- Come out of the train station and turn right onto the A6/Crescent
- Turn left on Statham Street into the Frederick Road Campus, you will pass the car parking barrier then turn left to cross the road at the zebra crossing
- You will then be facing the Allerton building
- Go into the Allerton Building and turn left
- Go out of the building from the doors which are facing the stairs (next to the car parking token machine)
- Turn right, and go through the small tunnel
- Turn left after leaving the tunnel and you will reach the large automatic doors which go into the Podiatry Department
